The secret ingredient to their LMS launch

The King's School took the approach of implementing DesignPLUS in tandem with their launch of Canvas to ensure the success and adoption of their new LMS platform. DesignPLUS was seen as the perfect supportive technology to help teachers, staff and course designers succeed in implementing Canvas due to its complementary and feature-rich toolset that makes it easy to build engaging and modern online resources.

The School simultaneously rolled out DesignPLUS to the Senior School, Preparatory School and Tudor House in 2020 resulting in their teachers being able to quickly develop and deploy pages that contained layered, interactive content that supported creative teaching practices for better student engagement and smoother cognitive apprenticeship.

Familiarity breeds success

Prior to the selection of Canvas and DesignPLUS, the school's previous LMS system had led to an inconsistent course design approach. The same courses incorporated varied digital resources, resulting in content that varied in quality and ultimately a confusing student experience.

Fast forward to today and The King's School now offers a unified, structured and supported approach which has led to a more consistent student experience, a high level of engagement, and improved quality of learning content.
